### EVACUATION ORDERS REMAIN IN EFFECT FOR AREAS OF SAN MATEO COUNTY

**WHAT:** Evacuation Orders

**WHEN:** Effective Immediately

**WHY:** Due to forecasted thunderstorms in the area, there is an increased risk of potential debris flows in areas in, and around, the CZU Lightning Complex burn area. A NOAA Flash Flood Warning has been extended for the region.

**WHERE:** **EVACUATION ORDERS:**

**(Zones: SMC-E019, SMC-E098, SMC-E038, SMC-E018)**

- South Coast Zone SMC-E019, which includes Coastanoa and Año Nuevo State Park. This includes Whitehouse Canyon Road and areas south of Gazos Creek Road.
- The Communities of Loma Mar and Dearborn Park in Zone SMC-E018.
- South Coast Zone SMC-038, which includes Butano State Park and the Community of Barranca Knolls, west of Cloverdale Road.
- The Community of Butano Canyon in Zone SMC-E-098

**NOTES:** A Temporary Evacuation Point (TEP) has been established at:  
Pescadero High School, 360 Butano Cutoff, Pescadero, CA 95060

- *This TEP will close at 5:00pm tonight*
