Corey and I went down to county records to better understand one of the comments in the report sent by Steven Rosen.

“This point of Loma Court is shown to be a County-Maintained Minor Road in the County of San Mateo’s *Index of Roads and Road Numbers by Classification*, by the Board of Supervisors’ Resolution No. 073100 on **April 8, 2014**”

There is an “Amended Map of Palomar Park” dated November 21st of 1927 that states;

“I Elizabeth M Kneese approve the within map entitled “Amended Map of Palomar Park” and accepted on behalf of the public, the offer for dedication of the streets called Loma Court, Cortez Road, and Estrada Place, and the 7 foot easements which are offered for dedication to public use....”

So what is Steven referring to or what is his point when calling out Resolution No. 073100 dated April 8th 2014.
